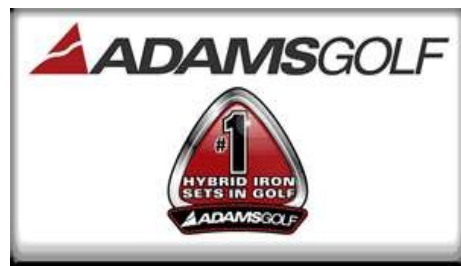

Only 83 days until they are hitting their tee shots for the first round of the Masters!

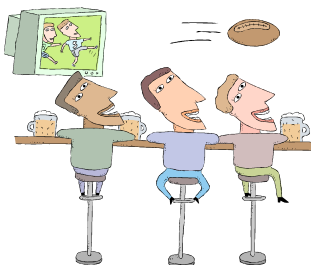
From the Pro Shop
