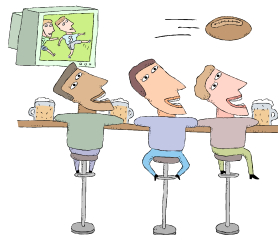
From the Pro Shop
